The subject of having an Air Cooled Car Recall has been brought up. This would include VW's, Stanley Steamers as well as Corvairs.


New Business-- Tech sessions-- We have people in the club who could use some help on their cars. How about getting together every once in a while to help someone to do the work? Perhaps every other month or so.

The meeting was adjourned at about? 8:15.



Kitchen Corner By Rita Turkey Almandine



Combine 1st 7 ingredients in saucepan and heat to bubbly. Pour into 9x13 pan. Pinch seams of crescent rolls together and place on top for a crust. Mix butter, almonds, and cheese and spread over top. Bake at 375° for 20 - 25 mins.

Southern Peach Yam Bake 1/2 c brown sugar 3 Tbl flour 1/2 tsp nutmeg 2 Tbl butter 1/2 c chopped pecans 2 (17oz) cans yams, drained 1 (16oz) can peach slices, drained 1 1/2 c mini marshmallows Combine sugar, flour & nutmeg. Cut in the butter, add pecans, Combine

yams & peaches in 1 1/2 qt cass. Sprinkle with sugar mixture. Bake at 350° for 35 mins. Top with marshmallows and broil till browned.


