Our meeting In December only had six people for the meeting; hope to see everyone at January's meeting




1963 CORVAIR PINNINFARINA


RAW MATERIALS FOR DISPLAY ENGINE

Kitchen Corner By Rita

Beef Stromboli 1/2 lb sweet Italian Sausage 1/4 lb ground beef 1 (7oz) can mushrooms, drained 1 lb frozen bread dough, thawed 1/2 c shredded mozzerella 1 tsp parmesan 1/2 tsp garlic powder 1/8 tsp each salt & pepper Brown and drain the sausage and beef. Add mushrooms and remove from heat. Roll dough out to 6 x 12 rectangle and Spread meat mixture. Mix remaining ingredients and sprinkle over meat. Fold dough over and pinch to seal. Put on greased baking sheet and bake at 425° For 15 - 18 mins.

Maple Apple Crunch 8 baking apples, peeled, cored & sliced 2 Tbl flour % c sugar 1 c maple syrup, divided 1 tsp cinnamon 1 1/2 c oatmeal 1 1/2 c flour % c brown sugar % c melted butter 1 tsp baking soda 1 tsp baking powder 1/2 c chopped nuts Combine 1st 5 ingredients with 1/2 c of the syrup. Put in ungreased 8 x 12 pan or 9" pie tin. Combine remaining ingredients with 1/2 c syrup and top the



1396 Daboll Rd, Memphis tel# 689-3366

From Exit 39 of the thruway; once off the exit go EAST on Rt 690 and keep to the right. Get off at the Jones Rd exit and turn left on Jones Rd. Go .3 miles to a traffic light and go straight through this—it will now change names to Brickyard Rd at this intersection. Continue straight 3 miles. This will be a "T" intersection at Rt 173. Turn right and go 2.5 miles to next blinking red light (this is Rt 31 and Rt 173). Go through this light and take a right kitty corner road named Elderberry. Turn right at the end of this and then the first left (within eyesight at the top of the knoll). This is Daboll. You'll come to a stop sign at Kingdom Rd. Go straight and we're the 3rd house on the left (total of 1.1 miles on Daboll Rd)
