

Salami Lover's Italian Pasta Salad 8 oz rotelli pasta, cooked and drained 3⁄4 c creamy salad dressing 3⁄3 c Italian style salad dressing 3⁄4 c grated parmesan cheese 8 oz salami, cubed 1 red bell pepper, thinly sliced 1 (2oz) can sliced black olives 1⁄2 red onion, julienned Mix both salad dressings and cheese. Add the pasta, salami, pepper, olives and onion. Chill.

Strawberry Key Lime Smoothie <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> banana <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> c frozen strawberries <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> c orange juice 1 container key lime yogurt Mix all in blender.

Orange Cream Cake 1 box yellow cake mix 1 small can mandarin oranges with juice 4 eggs <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> c oil Mix all and pour into 3 round cake pans. Bake at 350 for 15mins. Cool completely Icing; 1 large container cool whip 1 pkg vanilla instant pudding 1 (20 oz) can crushed pineapple, with juice Mix all and spread between layers

and on top of cake. Refrigerate.





From exit 39 of the thruway; once off the exit go EAST on Rt 690 and keep to the right. Get off at the Jones Rd exit and turn left on Jones Rd. Go .3 miles to a traffic light and go straight through this--- it will now change names to Brickyard Rd at this intersection. Continue straight 3 miles. This will be a "T" intersection at Warners Rd (Rt 173). Turn right and go 2.5 miles to next blinking light (this is Rt 31 and Rt 173). Go through this light and take a right kitty corner road named Elderberry. Turn right at the end of this and then the first left (within cycsight at the top of the knoll). This will be Daboll. You'll come to a stop sign at Kingdom Rd. Go straight and we're the 3<sup>rd</sup> house on the left (total of 1.1 miles on Daboll Rd).
