Marmalade Baked Ham

1 3 to 4 lb boneless ham 12 to 15 whole cloves 1 can beer ¹/₄ c brown sugar ¹/₂ c orange marmalade

Insert the cloves over the top of the ham. Pour the beer over the top. Rub the brown sugar all over, cover and bake at 325 for 1 \hat{A} ¹/₄ hr. Spread the marmalade on top of the ham and bake, uncovered, for 15 to 15 minutes.

Asparagus Stir Fry

- 2 c uncooked instant rice
- 2 c water
- 1 tsp oil
- 3 carrots, sliced 1 sml onion, cut in wedges
- 1 lb fresh asparagus, cut in 1â€ pieces
- 1 (8oz) pkg whole mushrooms, quartered
- 1/3 c water
- 1 tsp grated lemon peel
- ¹/₄ tsp thyme
- 1/4 tsp pepper

Cook rice and water as directed. Heat oil and saut© carrots and onion. Add asparagus and mushrooms, cook 4 mins. Stir in remaining ingredients and cook on medium for 2 to 3 mins. Serve over rice.

ZDDP

Ever hear of it? Well, it used to be in the oil you put in your car back in the 80's grade SF or SG. It is an E.P. (extreme pressure) additive, .18% to .20% by weight. It is a combination of zinc and phosphorous. The newest grade of oil, SM, contains only .08% phosphorous. The reason for the reduction is the good old EPA telling the auto manufacturers to increase the life of the catalytic converters and reducing the amount of ZDDP in the oil does just that.

Long Live Your Engine

Newer car engines have been redesigned to live with less ZDDP mostly by using roller tappets instead of flat tappets (cam followers) such as Corvairs engines use.

These flat tappets have what they call lifter foot pressure which can be 200 to 400 Lbs depending ob cam profile and valve spring pressure. High performance engines have higher foot pressures. The lack of a sufficient amount of ZDDP causes scuffing of the tappet and/or cam lobe, which, if serious enough would cause a skip at idle. There are several ways to get enough ZDDP in your engine.

1- find some good SF or SG oil

2- use a synthetic oil . Clark's is one source among other.

3- Buy a 4 oz bottle of ZDDP from Clark's for \$9.60. Good for one oil change.

ZDDP should not be used in OBD (new) cars. ZDDP stand for â€æzinc dialkyl-dithio-phosphate. Now you know why they call it ZDDP.

HI AGAIN

This was another super busy month. Phil's Rampy is coming along nicely...so nice I would be afraid to drive it! Another project for this winter will be ME? changing head gaskets on his 64 Spyder. This project grew rapidly into a long wish list of tweaks and upgrades. So it will be a while before it is back on the road.

The motor I took out of the Lakewood and installed in the Rampy to get us through the tour season worked out well, after fixing the sunken float in the right hand carb that showed up after a couple hundred miles, and the shorted coil that showed up later on. Now it runs great. Now I have replaced it with a brand new motor tailored more for the truck, and putting that powertrain back in the Lakewood where it belongs. I need to chase a few small details yet before driving it very far. Exasperating oil leaks and that type of stuff. Also I had hoped to install better seat belts and several other options in it.

I also am building a new complete powertrain for the 64 Coupe with factory A/C. of course the biggest part of the job is cleaning /rebuilding and painting parts ~! Now I am so far behind, I may just repair the existing incorrect engine so I can drive it sooner. I have rebuilt / repaired all the lights and e brake parts so far. It also now has those fancy new hands wheels I have always wanted installed.

I will be putting new tires on the rampy. I did not like the looks of them, and remembered it has been almost 20 years since I bought them (when I retired!). Check your tires for signs of dry cracked rubber between treads etc. also look close to the wheel for cracks from stress and dried out rubber.

I hope more of you start taking digital cameras with you to events. I cant be at all of them, so we miss out sometimes. Pictures make the newsletter more interesting and informative! Please do your part to help. Thanks to those that have sent me a few.

I need a few more pages each month to keep up with the progress Kevin , and Phil are making on their projects. Very ambitious stuff!! Kevin is redesigning his buggy project , and building a new motor for his coupe , Phil Domser is working on parts for his Rampy (almost completed in the body shop!) and the Loadside. Phil and I took a ride to check the progress on it , and the paint work looks like senior division work to me! (I would be afraid to drive something that nice.) Doug and Betsy are still working on paint issues on the van. Not sure who else is doing whatever out there yet.

Any news out there? Be sure to let me know, so it can be in print.

Jim is still looking for more exciting content for the website. See his note elsewhere in this issue.

A side addition to Ron's note on ZDDP additives, I use a LUCAS oil break in additive (says it has zinc in it!) product available at my local NAPA store. Not cheap, but right here handy. LUCAS Gas additives work very well also.

We sure had some nice Fall tours this year, with weather cooperating on most. It was nice to be able to drive a Corvair this year.

Preparations are progressing for next years RECALL. A few upgrades and changes are in the making. More on this in the next issue. I think that's it (hope I did not forget to much!!) for this month, I better get back to work... See ya soon!


