Kitchen Corner

Lobster Stew

2 Tbl diced onion

2 Tbl butter

$\frac{3}{4}$ c cooked lobster meat

1 Tbl sherry

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ c light cream

a pinch of paprika

salt and pepper to taste

freshly snipped chives for garnish

Saute the onion in the butter. Add lobster meat.

Add sherry and deglaze the pan. Add the cream, paprika and salt and pepper. Bring to a boil and serve immediately.

Old Fashioned Frog Eye Salad

1 $\frac{1}{3}$ c acini diPepe pasta

$\frac{1}{2}$ c sugar

1 Tbl flour

$\frac{1}{4}$ tsp salt

1 (20oz) can pineapple tidbits, undrained

1 (8oz) can crushed pineapple, undrained

1 egg, beaten

2 Tbl lemon juice

2 (11oz) cans mandarin oranges, drained

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ c cool whip

3 c mini marshmallows

$\frac{1}{2}$ c coconut

maraschino cherries

In medium saucepan, stir together the sugar, flour, salt. Drain pineapple, reserving juice to equal 1 cup. With whisk, gradually stir juice and egg into sugar mixture. Cook over med heat, stirring frequently until mixture comes to a boil. Stir in lemon juice. Cool mixture to room temp. Cook, drain, rinse pasta with cold water and let cool. Drain well. Stir together pineapple juice mixture and pasta. Cover, refrigerate several hours.

Add crushed pineapple and tidbits, oranges, 2 cups cool whip, marshmallows and coconut; mix gently and thoroughly. Cover and refrigerate until cold. Top with remaining cool whip. Garnish with cherries.
