Kitchen Corner

Pineapple Upside down Ham Loaf

3 Tbl butter

½ c brown sugar

canned pineapple slices

maraschino cherries

4 c ground cooked ham

2/3 lb ground pork

2 c bread crumbs

2 eggs, beaten

1 c milk

1 tsp salt

1/8 tsp pepper

½ tsp dry mustard

Melt butter and sugar; put in 8x8 casserole. Place pineapple rings and cherries on top of sugar mixture. Mix remaining ingredients and spread on top of pineapple. Bake at 350 for 1 ½ hr. Turn out onto platter and cut into squares.

Banana Foster Trifle

Pound cake, cubed; sprinkle with 2 Tbl rum; set aside

1 c caramel ice cream topping; mix with 2 Tbl rum; set aside

bananas, sliced; set aside

Filling;

1 pkg instant vanilla pudding

1 c heavy cream

1/2c whole milk

½ c sour cream

¼ c confectioner sugar

Mix filling ingredients till stiff peaks form.

In glass bowl layer half of the cake cubes, bananas, filling and caramel. Repeat layers.
