Corvair people,





Kitchen Corner
Baltimore Dogs
Sauté some onions and set aside.
Split hot dogs halfway through and

cook 4 to 7 mins. Put in a toasted bun and top with shredded cheddar cheese & top with the sautéed onions.

Honey Grilled Shrimp
1 (80z) bottle Italian dressing

1 c honey

1/2 tsp minced garlic

2 lbs uncooked med shrimp; peeled and deveined

Combine the dressing, honey and garlic. Set aside ½ cup. Pour remaining marinade into lrg resealable bag and add shrimp. Refrigerate 30 mins. Thread shrimp onto skewers, grill and baste with reserved marinade.

No bake Strawberry Dessert 1 angel food cake, cut into 1 inch cubes

- 2 (.3oz) pkgs sugar free strawberry jello
- 2 c boiling water
- 1 (20oz) pkg frzn unsweetened whole strawberries, thawed
- 2 c milk
- 1 (1oz) pkg sugar free inst vanilla pudding mix

1 carton cool whip

Arrange cubes in a 13x9 dish. In a bowl. dissolve jello in boiling water; stir in strawberries. Pour over cake and gently press down cake. Refrigerate till set, about 1 hr. Whisk milk and pudding

till thickened. Spoon over cake. Refrigerate.

TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

WOW! I am still in "information overload " **again** this month. Back again, with continuing sagas in my shop, and other "stuff". the last month here has been "different?" with Rita falling, injuring herself, ending up taking a ride in Jordan's ambulance (stolen from the parade by the call) on memorial day to the hospital for a week, and slowly recovering.

On my shop front, I found out the powerglide on my rampy is having a crazy problem upshifting after it gets warmed up. I have tried ALL possible external and a couple internal fixes, with the problem still there. This, along with some sort of timing gear type noise has set me back AGAIN. So now I have rebuilt a correct HD (355 pg) differential, another powerslide, and am in process of a new "mystery" motor. I hope this setup works better that the past ones. The WB (64 FC with PG) motor I bought cheap used, is going to be a core for another motor soon. I ran it a very short time, to check oil pressure and other problems. The fact that one needle in a carb was laying on the bottom of the bowl, and both accelerator pumps had no springs or clips on them, made it a challenge to run it a few seconds (well maybe one minute) to check it out. Some of the things you find on stuff that has been sitting a long time is fun!! Anyhow, I feel like I did better than a lot of my past deals on this motor and differential, so I was very happy!

I ended up replacing all bearings and seals in the differential, and took a few pictures to show the tools I use doing this job. I will be doing another differential very soon, a 3:27 for the crampy. It is apart waiting now.

The coupe is waiting for me to finish under dash wiring, muffler hangers for duals with stock mufflers on 140 manifolds etc, and putting the A/C back together.

So, as you can see, I am still hard at it out in the shop! My goal is still to get the truck and couper in very good mechanical shape, then maybe tackle body work myself also.

I am redoing a couple of buckets for the coupe with Clark's corvair kits, and a set of heaters. (in my spare? Time)

Just got a nice phone call from Phil Domser out in Beatrice Nebraska after his running the red "retired" fire dept corvan in the parade there celebrating the 100th anniversary of the fire dept. he said the people there loved it. So he and daughter Megan had a lot of fun at the town "party". HOPEFULLY he took a lot of pictures with his new camera. From there they head for the CORSA 50th year of corvairs celebration in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. I *hope* to have a picture report in this newsletter next month.

I hope we all remember to thank the vendors who GAVE us trophies, and door prizes for the "RECALL" and bought space in the program. Thanks to all who attended, and worked hard on it also.

I still have a lot of hard work ahead on corvair stuff, so my ham radio antenna work will wait a little longer yet.

Hope to see you all at the picnic.
