

Directions to Tassone's

Tassone's is located right on the corner of Dexter Parkway and Rt 370 in Baldwinsville directly across the road from Cooper's Marina. From the south, take Rt 690 north and go to the <u>2nd</u> Baldwinsville exit (this will be Rt 370). Turn left off the exit and go about 1/2 mile. It'll be on your left. From the west take Rt31 to the 690 interchange and take it north over the river to the Rt 370 exit, left off the exit and go about 1/2 mile on the left. From the east take Rt 31 to the center of B'ville — go straight and continue on Rt 370 west — it will be on your right about a mile (or less) from the 4 corners in B'ville. Kitchen Corner By Rita

Marmalade Baked Ham 3 to 4 lb boneless ham 12 - 15 whole cloves 1 can beer ½ c brown sugar ½ c orange marmalade Insert cloves into ham. Pour Beer over top. Rub brown sugar over top. Cover and bake at 325 for 1 ¼ hrs. Remove and spread marmalade over top. Bake uncovered for an additional 15 to 25 mins.

Asparagus Stir Fry

2 c uncooked instant rice

2 c water

1 tsp oil

3 carrots, sliced

1 sml onion, cut into 8 wedges

1 lb fresh asparagus, cut into 1" pieces

1 (8oz) pkg whole mushrooms, quartered

1/3 c water

1 tsp grated lemon peel

½ tsp thyme

½ tsp pepper

Cook rice and water as directed. Heat oil; add carrots and onions; cook 2 mins. Add remaining ingredients, stir in, cover and cook on medium for 2 to 3 mins. Serve over rice.


