Directions to Tassone's

Tassone's is located right on the corner of Dexter Parkway and Rt 370 in Baldwinsville directly across the road from Cooper's Marina. From the south, take Rt 690 north and go to the 2nd Baldwinsville exit (this will be Rt 370). Turn left off the exit and go about 1/2 mile. It'll be on your left. From the west take Rt31 to the 690 interchange and take it north over the river to the Rt 370 exit, left off the exit and go about 1/2 mile on the left. From the east take Rt 31 to the center of B'ville — go straight and continue on Rt 370 west — it will be on your right about a mile (or less) from the 4 corners in B'ville. If you need help getting there, you can call Tim's cell at 415-4243 or Rita at 412-1880.

Kitchen Corner Chicken Divan

**2 (10 oz) pkgs frozen broccoli,
cooked, drained well & chopped
6 c shredded cooked chicken
2 cans cream of mushroom soup
1 c mayonnaise
1 c sour cream
1 c grated cheddar cheese
1 Tbl lemon juice
salt and pepper
½ c dry white wine
½ c grated parmesan
½ c bread crumbs
2 Tbl melted butter**
Mix the drained broccoli and shredded chicken. In a medium bowl combine the soup, mayonnaise, cheddar, lemon juice, salt and pepper and wine. Whisk together to make a sauce. Pour over the chicken and broccoli. Mix well. Put in a greased 11 x 7 casserole dish. Combine the parmesan, bread crumbs and butter and sprinkle over the top. Bake at 350° 30 to 45 mins.

Cranberry Chutney

**1 c water
4 c fresh cranberries, 1 c raisins
2 c sugar
½ tsp ginger, 1 tsp cinnamon
½ tsp allspice, ½ tsp salt
1 (8oz) can crushed pineapple,
drained – then enough water added to equal 1 cup Mix all but the pineapple and raisins. Cook covered till cranberries are plump. Add pineapple and raisins & cook addl
10 mins. Keeps well, chilled, for 2 weeks.**






