





# Kitchen Corner

Bourbon Steak
2 tenderloin steaks, 1 1/2 " thick
2 Tbl bourbon
2 Tbl brown sugar
1/4 tsp pepper
Mix the bourbon, brown sugar and

pepper.
Rub on steak and grill.

Skillet Potatoes with Bacon and Cheese 4 slices bacon, cut in ½ " pieces 1 onion, chopped

2 lbs potatoes, thinly sliced

1 c shredded cheddar cheese

6 Tbl sour cream

Cook bacon till crisp. Drain, leave 3 Tbl in skillet. Add onions cook and stir 5 mins. Stir in potatoes; cover. Cook on medium – low heat 20 to 25 mins or till potatoes are tender, stirring occasionally. Top with cheese and bacon; cook, covered 1 to 2 mins or till cheese is melted.

# TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

GREETINGS AGAIN, from my lit*tle shop in Memphis* , NY.

Well, another exciting month in my shop!. Lots of problems to fix, and mostly on my own vehicles this time.

We made it to the Fairhaven show, another nice time. After that show visit, we continued west along the lake on a long day trip in the rampy.

We enjoy taking a lot of "day trips" in the rampy, but gas prices on HIGH TEST, shorten them sometimes.

Phil Domser, and his daughter Megan, are on their way home from the CORSA nationals in Denver CO as I write this. They have pictures to share, but I have not been able to get them yet. Dennis Randall came up to an auction last week to buy Ken Hinmans 67 convert, hot out of the barn. He plans on bringing it back to life soon.

It sure was nice to see the RECALL go well again, great job folks!

Some of the pictures below show what I run into at times. I am building a couple of secondary carbs for my new motor in my spare? Time. One I took apart for the top cover greeted me with collapsed floats and a crack in the bowl. It must have been full of water and froze up. I never saw floats so bad before!

Another picture shows what I found in 3 carburetor choke pull offs that failed me. I am thinking our new wonderful gas products contributed to these failures. Yet another picture depicts a transmission failure I had this month. And to top it off, I took a @30 mile trip at highway speeds and came home very happy with how it was running. Now the down fall comes along next day. I went to use it the next day to go to an appointment. I started it up to hear a LOUD one cylinder tap noise. I am guessing a valve seat came loose when it sat after getting it warm. Any how that sure sets my mood!. That motor is on the bench waiting for me to check it out and fix it (with 110hp headsa!) these heads have less that 2000 miles on them, after expensive local shop work.

So I say , make sure your work is done by a CORVAIR mechanic ,one who understands the situation with air cooled aluminum motors , it ends up cheaper to do it right the first time. So needless to say , I am very tired of seeing my motors on the jack.

The shop has remained ALMOST cool enough to work in this year , even on those 100 degree days. I would still rather be to hot than too cold!

I hope to be at the VW show, Jordan Fall Festival, and a couple of others. PLEASE watch for pre registration for Jordan, I will send it as soon as it comes out. YOU MUST REGISTER EARLY!!, and also please get there early, it is very hard to hold parking spaces there.
