Kitchen Corner

Peaches and Cream French Toast

1 (16 oz) loaf French bread, cut into
8 diagonal slices
1 (8 oz) pkg cream cheese, softened
1/3 cup peach preserves
3 eggs, beaten
1/2 cup milk
1/2 tsp vanilla ext
1/4 tsp cinnamon
powdered sugar & maple syrup

Cut a pocket into each slice, being careful
not to slice through the bread. Combine cream
cheese and preserves. Spoon evenly into each
pocket. Beat eggs, milk, vanilla and cinnamon
in another bowl. Dip stuffed bread in egg mixture.
Spray griddle and cook slices over medium heat
until golden brown. Dust with powdered sugar &
drizzle with maple syrup.

Bourbon Glazed Ham

1 (9 to 10 lb) cooked bone in ham
1 tsp whole cloves
1 cup dark brown sugar
2 Tbl ground mustard
1/4 cup bourbon

Place ham in sprayed 15 x 10 shallow baking
pan. Score in diamond pattern and insert cloves.
Bake at 325 for 1 hr. Stir together brown sugar,
mustard and bourbon. Brush half of this over
ham. Bake 30 mins. Brush with remaining sugar
mixture. Bake 40 to 50 mins longer. If pan
drippings start to burn, add 1/4 cup water to pan.
Remove pan from oven, cover with foil & let
stand 15 mins before carving.

Marmalade Candied Carrots

2 lbs fresh baby carrots, cook to crisp tender
2/3 cup orange marmalade
3 Tbl brown sugar
2 Tbl butter 1/2 cup chopped pecans, Toasted
1 tsp rum extract

Combine marmalade, sugar and butter & heat till
thickened. Stir in pecans and extract. Drizzle over
carrots and stir to coat.

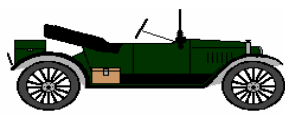

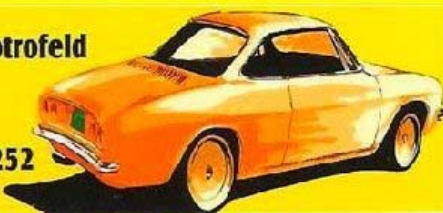

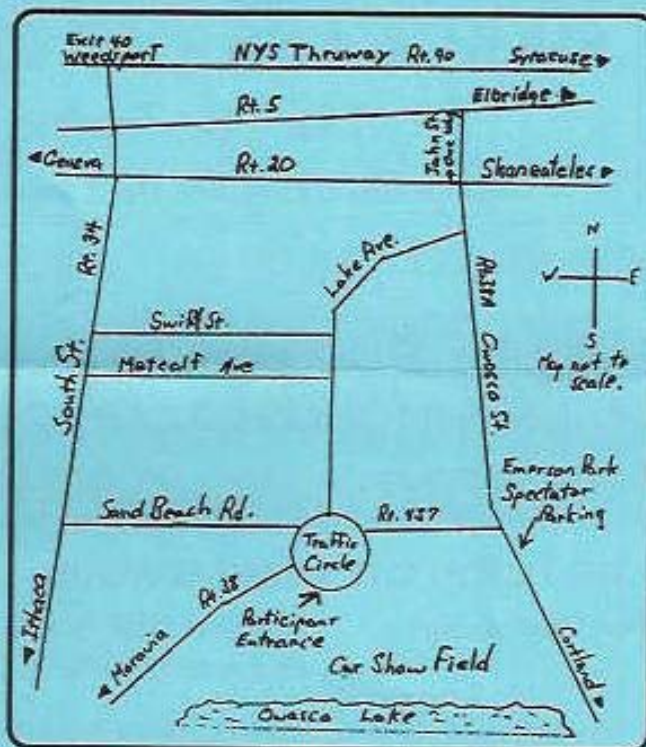
