






GEORGIA ROVING by Len Smith Our roving reporter is either out roving and looking for more shows to write about or taking a nice summer nap out by the pool.

Kitchen Corner

Shrimp Tartlets

 (8oz) pkg cream cheese, softened
 ½ tdp Worcestershire sauce
 tsp grated onion
 tsp garlic salt
 1/8 tsp lemon juice
 (1.9oz each) pkgs frozen mini phyllo tart shells
 z seafood sauce
 cooked med shrimp, peeled & deveined Combine 1st five ingredients. Spoon into tart shells. Top with seafood sauce and shrimp.
 Refrigerate till served.

Hula Sliders

½ c mayonnaise
¼ c plus 2 Tbl pineapple preserves
1/8 tsp plus ½ tsp salt
1 ¼ lb ground beef
¼ tsp onion powder
¼ tsp pepper
6 slices pepper jack cheese, each cut into quarters
1 (12 count) small dinner or slider rolls

Combine mayo, ¹/₄ c pineapple preserves, & 1/8 tsp salt; mix well and refrigerate.

Preheat grill to med. Combine beef, remaining 2 Tbl preserves, onion powder, remaining ½ salt and pepper; mix well. Divide into 12 patties. Grill patties 4 to 6 mns or till done. Place 2 pieces of cheese on Each one. Place on roll and top with mayo/ Pineapple sauce.

Two Minute Hawaiian Pie

- 1 (20 oz) can crushed pineapple in syrup, undrained
- 1 (6 serving size) pkg instant vanilla pudding 1 (8oz) sour cream
- 1 (9") prepared shortbread pie crust
- 1 (8oz) can sliced pineapple, drained & halved
- 8 maraschino cherries, drained
- 2 Tbl sweetened flaked coconut

Combine crushed pineapple with syrup, dry Pudding mix & sour cream; mix till combined. Spoon into pie shell and decorate the top with Pineapple & cherries; sprinkle with coconut. Cover and chill at least 2 hours.






