Kitchen Corner

Red Onion Focaccia

3 frozen bread dough rolls, thawed ½ tsp olive oil 2 red onions, sliced & separated into rings ½ tsp Italian seasoning 2 Tbl shredded parmesan 1 Tbl butter, melted 1/8 tsp garlic salt

On a lightly floured surface, kneed dough together. Roll out into a 7" circle. Place on greased 7 ½ " pizza pan or baking sheet. Brush with oil. Top with onion slices. Sprinkle with Italian seasoning & parmesan. Bake at 350 for 28 to 32 mins. Combine butter and garlic salt; brush over warm foccacia. Cool 10 mins before serving.

Bacon Cheeseburger Lasagna
1 ½ lb ground beef
2 med onions, chopped
½ tsp salt, 1/8 tsp pepper
1 (28oz) can chunky tomato sauce
1 c water
1 egg
1 (15oz) ricotta cheese
1 c shredded Swiss cheese
¼ c chopped fresh parsley
8 slices bacon, crisply cooked and crumbled
12 uncooked lasagna noodles
2 c shredded cheddar cheese

Spray a 9 x 13 pan. Cook beef, onions, salt & pepper till brown; drain. Stir in tomato sauce & water. Heat to boiling; reduce heat & simmer 10 mins. In med bowl beat egg with fork. Stir in ricotta, Swiss, parsley and ¼ c of the bacon. Spread 1 cup of beef mixture in pan. Top with 4 uncooked noodles. Spread half of ricotta, 2 cups beef mixture and ¾ cup of cheddar over noodles. Repeat layers. Top with remaining noodles, beef mixture, cheddar & bacon. Spray a 15" sheet of foil. Cover lasagna, refrigerate 2 hrs. Bake at 350 covered 45 mins, then uncover & bake 30 mins.

Frozen Peanut Butter Squares
3 c finely crushed oreos
6 Tbl butter, melted
2 ½ c heavy cream
1 (14oz) can condensed milk
1 c peanut butter
1 (3.29oz) king sized Snickers bar, chopped

TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

HI THERE! Still working away in the shop most days.

This month has sure been a busy one. We did the Port Byron show with a few club members, and had a good time. Then we did the VW show with several of our club members setting up. I was sitting there minding my business, when a long time friend and his daughter stepped up and out of the blue said "I want to buy your 61 Lakewood". After my recovery from that statement, He said his 16 year old daughter was the one who was really buying it. So Rita and I left at 3PM, figuring I had not cleaned the truck enough to win anything, and came home to display the wagon. They bought it "on the spot". They picked it up the next night with a car dolly. So now I am working on a 62 Lakewood Monza "project car" I bartered. I got a "real deal" on it by giving the 140hp motor, and the wheels and tires back. I plan on building a new motor etc for the Rampy, and moving the present setup to the Lakewood. I will have a lot of work to do, but it is mostly with things I already have here, or came with it. I have already removed the motor and delivered it, and made new 64 style rear lights for it. I was fretting over the wrong rear bumper that came with it, but found I have a decent one here in the rafters. I am in the process of removing all brake parts along with tubing and hoses. I will clean and repaint the backing plates with the sturdy rust coatings made by KBR. I use the same very sturdy coatings on the floors and exposed parts. I have to repair the trunk bottom and paint the trunk. I am converting the single speed wipers to 2 spd with washers. I am converting the brakes to a later model dual master cylinder with silicone fluid for better safety. Then I have a new gas heater to install along with a Spyder dash. I have a custom made Clark's door panel set, made with 64 style (map pockets) and a bright red early color with matching padded dash and carpets. Add a set of Hands wheels with new Michelin tires, and it should make a nice driver. I forgot to mention, this car will be named "Daisy" and driven by Rita with HER Ham call plates on it.

Then, to top it off I got a call after the VW show was over that the Rampy won another first place award! That was a surprise, but I did notice two guys coming back and really looking it over again. The VW club really does a nice job at that show with all setups, they stopped by and admired the girls food spread, and asked if we needed anything several times during the day. The food they sold was very good, and they cranked a lot of hungry people thru there very efficiently. So we look forward to next years show, and they say the will probably add french fries to the menu.

A lot of interesting things are planned this fall for us car nuts, so keep your eye on your e mails!! A few of us will be missing this year at the Wampsville show because of a conflict with the show at Clark's Corvair in Selburne Falls Massachusetts.

Please remember that we must try hard to group up early on the day of the Jordan Fall festival car show to insure our spot. It is a first come first parking spot show. It is hard to save spots without causing stress.
