### Kitchen Corner

Valentine Day Salad

1 pkg Spring mix salad

1 cucumber, sliced

2 red peppers, seeded & with tops and bottoms removed

1 bunch radishes, sliced

1 small brick of mozzarella

10 -15 small plum tomatoes, halved

½ pkg salad topping crunchies, like a sesame stick type topping

1 bottle raspberry vinegrette

Using a small heart shaped cookie Cutter, cut out heart shapes from the Cucumber, red peppers and mozzarella. Sprinkle the veggies over the salad, then the crunchies and dressing.

Chicken Tettrazini
12 oz fettuccini, cooked, drained
1 c sliced mushrooms
½ c onion, chopped
7 Tbl butter, divided
¼ c flour
¼ tsp pepper
2 c half and half
¼ c chicken broth
2 c cooked chicken, chopped
1/3 c grated parmesan
1 c bread crumbs

Saute mushrooms & onion in 1
Tbl butter, remove from skillet. Melt
4 Tbl butter in skillet; whisk in flour,
salt & pepper, stirring till smooth &
bubbly. Add half and half; boil 1 minute. Remove from heat; mix in broth,
chicken, Fettuccini, & mushroom
mixture. Spoon Into a greased 9 x 13
pan. Sprinkle with Parmesan. Melt
remaining butter and Mix with bread

### TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

### **HELLO AGAIN EVERYBODY!**

Here I am again , yes, another crammed month. My plan was to work on my own projects until the first of the year , Well I did put in several hours on the turbo motor on the bench , and check out problems on the blue Spyder convertible. I will have to tear it down after all. In the meantime , thanks to a post on vitual vairs , the wire wheels are sold. So I will remove them when I am done with this issue.

My fun with the Lakewood continues . I have finished the brake rebuild , and the main and engine wire harness modifications. You have no idea how much fun I have had fixing all the things on this project. I repaired the heater box and blower , AND added a gas heater. It will give some heat without burning the gas , or burn gas and really heat things up. I added the extra wires for the Spyder dash, and a vacuum gauge feed pipe to the harness. I added a heavy main power feed to the front of the car for gas heater and different head lights etc. I converted it to a dual master cylinder and silicone fluid. I also had to remove the gas tank and repair leaks. I think I am almost ready to put gas in it , and start it up. Then I get to put an exhaust system on it. I have 140 manifolds on it and dual mufflers and pipes. Then I have to install the interior carpets and door panels. I am not sure what is up with only outer seat belt mounts , none on the inside. I feel like I have been building a car from the ground up....A lot of rust repairs and "cover ups". The outside of the car has a few areas of damage from storage etc , but has a pearl white paint in fair shape. Repairs were done to fenders with marine fiberglass which I left alone for now. It will never be a "show car" but will be a fun driver. I have put a few pictures of the work involved so far. I think I came up with a sturdy replacement for the red plastic hot wire tie point as used on late models , needed on Alternator conversions. I used a positive terminal from an alternator . On the Lakewood , I put it on the panel next to the battery . This way , I feed the post from the inside , out of sight. It looks neat , and is fail proof. Now I have to set it aside and get on with The broken blue Spyder.

When I get done with Phil's car, I need to fix up the rampy damage from spilled waste oil. The motor is covered with it, the cover was beyond repair, and the 10X10 tent is soaked with oil. So right now, the truck has no cover, which I need for the things I take to car shows, chairs, tables, etc. I hope to build something nice in time for this season.

The white / red rampy I worked on last winter, is undergoing a heavy body repair, and will back on the road this summer. We look forward to another nice show season. As far as travels, we will only go to our VT show and local fun shows this year. We also have Ham radio events coming up.
