#### Kitchen Corner

#### Orange Pineapple Salad

1 ( 6oz ) pkg orange jello
1 c. boiling water
1 ( 3oz ) pkg cream cheese, softened
½ c mayonnaise
1 Tbl vinegar
1 ½ c carrot, grated
1 ( 8oz ) can pineapple tidbits, drained
Combine Jello and water; stir until dissolved.
Add cream cheese, mayonnaise and vinegar; mix until blended and refrigerate until partially set.
Add carrot and pineapple and mix well. Chill until set.

#### **Baked Reuben Sliders**

1 pkg Hawaiian Sweet rolls, sliced open ½ c 1000 Island dressing ½ lb corned beef, sliced thin 1 lb sauerkraut, drained ¼ lb Swiss cheese, sliced 2 Tbl butter, melted

Preheat oven to 350°. Butter a 9 x 13 baking pan. Put bottom side of rolls in the pan, spread ¼ c of the dressing on the rolls, then layer the corned beef on the roll halves. Spread sauerkraut on the corned beef. Then layer the Swiss cheese and the remaining dressing. Put roll tops on each. Brush butter over tops. Place in the oven for 15 to 20 mins or until cheese melts. Remove from oven and cut out each roll.

#### Green Velvet Cheesecake Bars

1 c graham cracker crumbs
1 c chocolate graham cracker crumbs
1 stick butter, melted
1 oz green food coloring
3 (8oz) pkgs cream cheese, softened
2/3 c sugar
3 eggs
½ tsp vanilla extract
green sprinkles

Preheat oven to 350°. Butter a 9x9 pan. Combine both graham crumbs, butter and green coloring. Stir well to combine and press into the bottom of the prepared pan. Beat together cream cheese and sugar. Add eggs and mix well. Stir in vanilla extract. Pour Mixture on the crust. Bake 40 mins or until center is set. Cool for 15 mins, then refrigerate to cool completely before slicing. Top with sprinkles.

#### TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

HELLO AGAIN from the little Corvair Shop in Memphis NY.

Another month has slipped by with not a lot of Corvair activity in the shop Today is too good to believe, almost 70 degrees in February? Too bad it probably wont last. We are looking forward to warmer weather.

I just worked a while in the shop yesterday, finishing up details on a new FC motor I built for the Rampy. I have a new rebuilt 64 FC transaxle to mate with it. The 64 and 65 FC, and 65 up cars powerglides were upgraded to handle the extra horse-power of the 164CU inch motors. I was lucky enough to parts out a 64 Greenbrier van a few years ago with original parts in it. I have always had early Transmissions against slightly upgraded 164CU Inch motors. I have suffered issues due to inadequate transmission capability. I plan on redoing the cylinders and pistons on the motor in the truck, then selling it.

I am working on replacing all but the indicator bulbs in my vehicles with brighter L E D bulbs. I have always wanted brighter gauge lights in the truck. I finally found some.

I am waiting for lifting help to get the club display motor off the trailer, and the next one on my rolling work bench. After that things should move forward .I have a lot of ideas for the display trailer, I just hope I can do it all soon. Then I hope to get it to any shows we go to. I still need to clean out some of my parts stash. I ended up with a lot that I bought from Ron's and the Lottito East Syracuse collection. I have late model differentials and other parts here that I will never use. I also have one very good early windshield to sell. I also have 2 Clark's Black seat kits, with 2 complete seats to build for a 64 for sale. Make yourself a new set, and keep your old ones. I really need the space some of these things are taking up.

After I finish the Cord project, I hope to get the Lakewood finished and on the road, and then the coupe paint work. Both have nice new motors and transaxles in them. I have been running everything about once a month this year during the winter months.

We are hoping for better conditions this year for day trips in the Corvairs. We like to just get in and go on nice relaxed rides, sometimes including a simple enjoyable picnic.

We plan on a few local shows this year, along with the Recall. This years Recall planning is going well with a few "tweaks" to the weekend. The gang is working hard on it.


We are looking forward to another fine food event at Orchard Valle. It has always been a good feed!




