#### Kitchen Corner

#### Sunshine Salad

34 lb mixed baby greens
1 pint fresh, washed, hulled & sliced strawberries
2 oranges, peeled & sliced
1 (8oz) bottle Italian dressing
1/2 small onion, finely chopped
1/2 c crumbled blue cheese

Combine greens, berries & oranges. In a small bowl combine remaining ingredients except blue cheese. Mix well and add to greens. Toss and sprinkle with blue cheese.

#### Corn Dog Muffins

1 (8 ½ oz) pkg cornbread mix ½ c brown sugar ½ c butter, melted & slightly cooled 2 eggs, beaten 1 c milk ½ c shredded cheddar cheese 4 hot dogs, cut into small pieces mustard & catsup for garnish

In a bowl combine dry corn bread mix, brown sugar, butter, eggs & milk; mix well. Fold in cheese & hot dogs. Fill greased muffin cups about <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> full. Bake at 375 for 15 to 20 mins, until golden. Serve warm with mustard & catsup.

#### Strawberry Rhubarb Pie

1 qt strawberries, washed, hulled & quartered 1 c sugar 1 (15 oz) pkg refrigerated pie crusts, room temp 1 c cubed fresh rhubarb 1/3 c flour 1 Tbl butter, melted

Preheat to 425. Combine berries & sugar, mix well until sugar dissolves. Unfold 1 crust and put in 9" deep dish pie plate. Add rhubarb, flour & butter to strawberries. Mix well and put into pie crust. Make cut outs into top crust for decorative crust and put on top. Pinch together and trim edges to seal. Bake 30 to 35 mins. Cool slightly before serving

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#### TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

Greetings from "The Little Corvair Shop in Memphis NY". .Some months I have a hard time getting inspired to get this column together. Then I get rolling and run out of space!

With all the Covid 19 Virus stuff going on , for who knows how long , everything to do with gatherings is so up in the air nobody can plan on events to add to the calendar. This could take 90 days or 90 YEARS , they don't really know how to handle this mystery yet. This is all like a bad dream. There is too much unknown involved , and overanxious people may just make it last longer. The discussions I have heard from medical people make me wonder if they will ever get it really under control Our doctors suggest staying away from crowds and groups for now. Our radio clubs have switched to Zoom meetings (on the internet) so we are staying up to date with them , plus most of us are "on the air" talking together often. (https://zoom.us/ for info)

My life is mostly out in the shop, working hard on tasks to do with the 8 dr van project. Once again I have had not much input from our long lost members. I am still working many hours a month on the 8 dr van project. I am now doing the brake system over. It is getting all new tubing, converted to dual master cylinder, and silicone fluid. Then it gets a new wiring harness made to accept a few extra options such as a Spyder dash and gas heater. Then the gas tank can go back in, and the powertrain reinstalled to all new motor mounts. This also has the Clark's full fin .060 oversize cylinders and a 260 cam with 3:55 rebuilt differential, and powerglide.

This winter I hope to get started on bodywork for my 64 coupe with A/C. The body is rust free, but paint got fried in Texas heat. Most of the mechanical work is done, and it is a very nice driving car. It has a 110hp with my trademark Clark's .060 oversize full fin cylinders and a snappy cam. It feels like a real good performer. Now to make it look better.

As for the newsletter (C N Y C C FAN) It has been a chore for us this month with everything going on. PLUS someone did a "reply all" to one I sent out resulting in complaints about having all the addresses visible. I have not mastered Blind Carbon Copy, and am just a volunteer so for now I am NOT forwarding anything except to our club members. There has always got to be one...

I will work on it when I get time. In the meantime because a newsletter is required to maintain our C O R S A status, we will continue. I also have one of the motors from Ron's on the bench to go thru and clean up to sell someday. I am still waiting to see if we get a Turbo motor donated to make a new display. With that and what I have here, and a lot of work, we can make an eye catching display. It will take time to pull it together, but I guess there is no rush now that shows are non existent.

There are rumblings out there to get the group together. We feel it is not safe for us to do so yet.

I put a few pictures of Bill O'Neils 63 coupe project on the picture page. That car is coming along nicely. It is a very clean car from Denver Colorado area that has been through a super body and paint job. Bill is doing a lot of detail work on it now. Also I put the latest pictures of Phil Domser's Loadside in the shop down in Groton. It is almost done. This truck came from way out west and had almost no rust on it. It had the early (61) shifter, so got converted to a late style shift lever (not a job for the faint at heart!). It required a different gas tank, and reinforcing of the floor where the shift lever mounts. But the results are well worth it.

## THIS IS THE 63 COUPE THAT BILL O'NEIL IS RESTORING TO DRIVE , SHOW , AND ENJOY THE POWERTRAIN WAS ONE OF MY "WINTER PROJECTS"

It got a full rebuild of the motor, and differential. It is a very nice running 102hp pure stock (except the Clark's oil pan). It got the Clarks "bullet proof" throw out sleeve, all new bearings, clutch setup and U joints etc. It is a 4 speed car.








These are updated pictures of Phil Domser's Loadside project. It is Palomar red with a white band. It has a Spyder dash, conversion to late style shifter, and a custom made 4 carb motor setup. It has Clark's full fin .060 cylinders, a 260 cam, and custom carbs with all 4 having idle circuits. It was converted to a high output alternator. It has a dual master cylinder, and all new brake parts with silicone fluid. I had the 110hp heads made into 4 carbs by welding extra carb mounts in the stock 140 configuration. This way, stock 140 linkage, fuel lines, etc can be used. The only hard part is design of air cleaners.. It also has a set of side pipes which are functional (and LOUD). It is getting a new seat and mats also. It will be getting a gas heater installed later.



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
