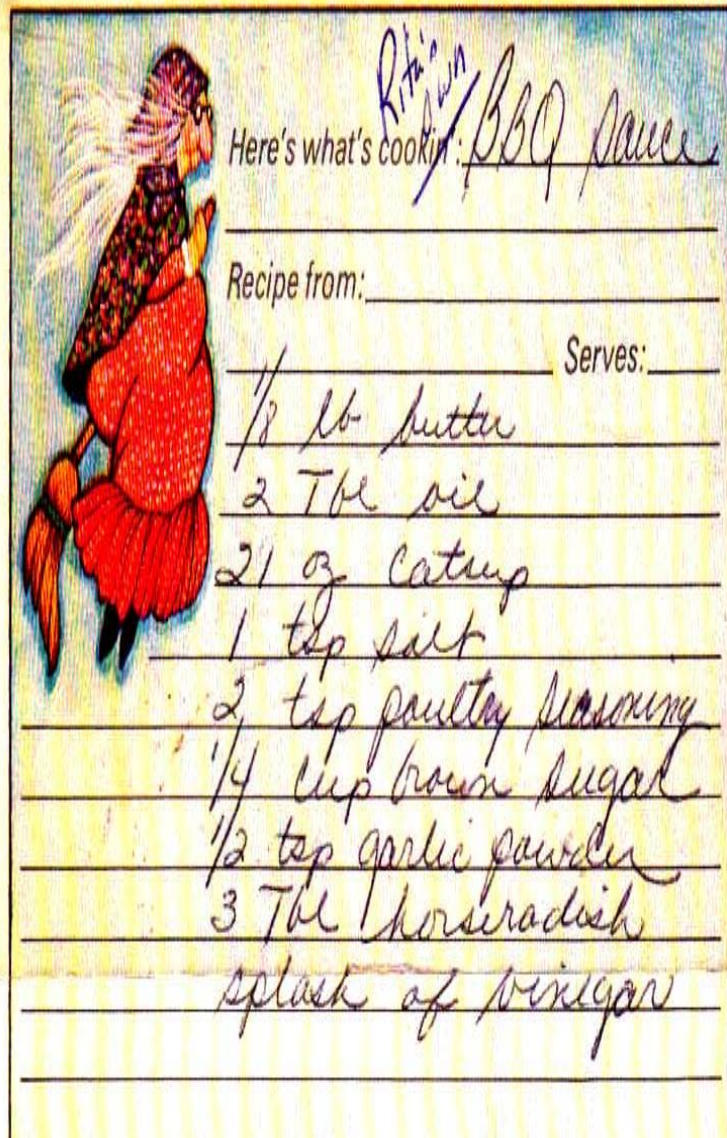

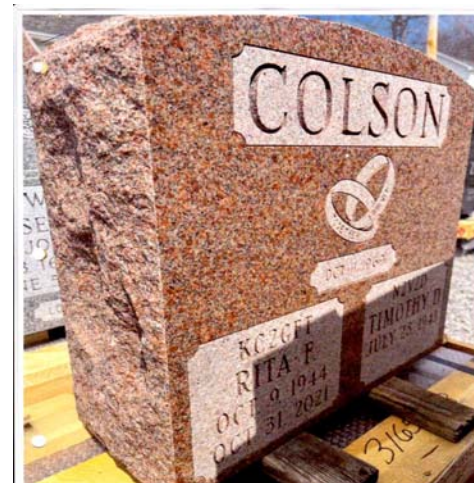
The group working on this years Recall is coming along nicely. It will be different, but surely a fun time. I think that location will be fun and the owners are very willing to help.

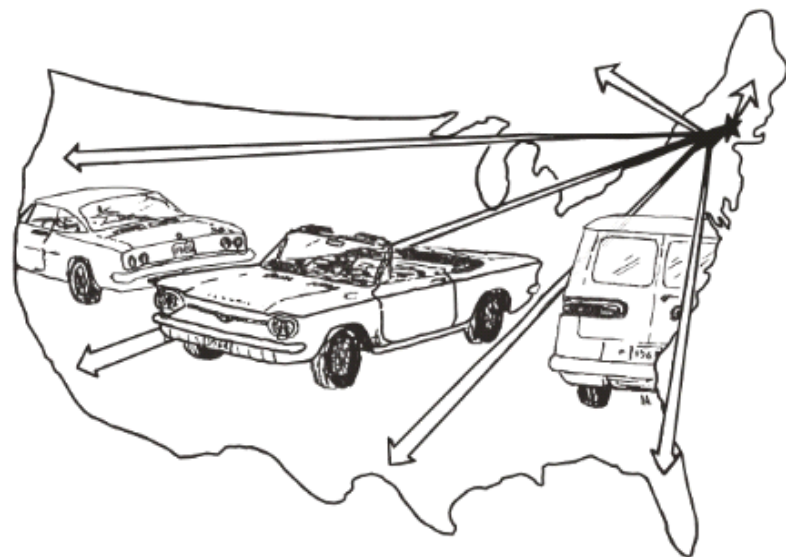

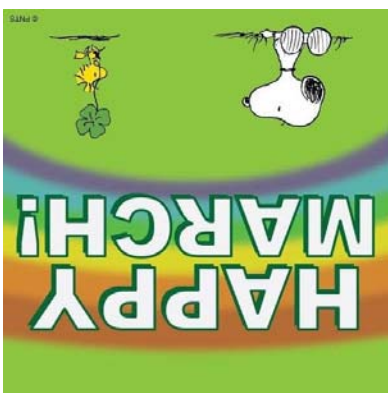

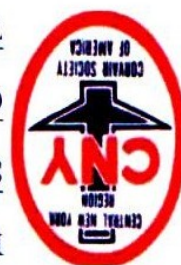
