Kitchen Corner
FROM A STACK I FOUND RECENTLY
I will try to scan or rewrite more soon.

Macaroni and Ham Casserole Serves 4 to 6

1 medium onion, chopped

2 tablespoons butter

1 can condensed cream of celery soup

1 (14-1/2-ounce) diced tomatoes, drained

1/4 teaspoon thyme

dash pepper

1 cup uncooked macaroni, cooked as directed on package

8 to 12 ounces cooked ham, deli is fine, cut in strips

1/4 cup chopped green bell pepper

1/2 cup shredded cheese(s), your choice

In a heavy skillet, cook onion in butter over medium-low heat until onion is tender but not browned. Stir in soup, tomatoes, thyme, and pepper. Add cooked macaroni, ham, and green bell pepper; stir in half of the cheese (1/4 cup). Transfer mixture to a lightly greased 1-1/2 quart casserole. Top with remaining 1/4 cup shredded cheese. Bake at 350°F for 30 to 40 minutes, or until heated through.

dessert

Pineapple Au Gratin

3/4 c. sugar

3 tbsp. flour or cornstarch

1 lg. can pineapple chunks

1 c. grated sharp cheddar cheese

Mix together and put in flat baking dish. Cover with crumbled Ritz crackers. Drizzle with melted butter. Bake at 350 degrees 20 to 30 minutes until brown.

Greetings from "The Little Corvair Shop in Memphis NY". .Some months I have a hard time getting inspired to get this column together. Once again I have had not much input from our long lost members.

I WONDER HOW MANY MORE YEARS I CAN STAND TO DO THIS NEWSLETTER. It is important to keep a newsletter going to maintain our chapter status with C O R S A>

My truck is still not done. I have replaced the head, but strange things have happened while apart not related to the bad seat and valve guide testing my patience. Starter drive went bad, and possibly the fuel pump. Corvair fuel pumps are getting to be a problem. Mine just plain quit pumping while sitting. I have checked everything out. I HAVE A NEW PUMP COMING IN THE MORNING. It has a lifetime warranty. I am so sick of pump failures! I have plans to build 2 more motors soon, one may be for Rampy. My shop right now is crammed with work to do, but I am working slowly and not without aches and pains. I am registered for Port Byron and Jordan, but not sure if I can be there with Rampy Yet. Yes I am very unhappy about how things have gone this year.

other projects looming are Carburetors and Alternators for the new motors. I was able to get 5 of the internal regulated alternators as cores to build. Used ones are getting scarce.. It also takes time and chemicals (not cheap!) to clean and refurbish all the parts involved In a motor project. These parts are getting older and in rougher condition.

I am looking for help getting my coupe painted now. It is mostly apart waiting. It also needs a small amount of other work .That car should be fun to drive, it is very perky on the road with that cam and cylinder combination..

No overnight parkingGates will open for show cars at 7 a.m.**Early Birds NOT permitted**




