## Kitchen Corner

### Sunshine Salad

¾ lb mixed baby greens  
1 pint fresh , washed, hulled & sliced strawberries  
2 oranges, peeled & sliced  
1 ( 8oz ) bottle Italian dressing  
½ small onion, finely chopped  
½ c crumbled blue cheese

Combine greens, berries & oranges. In a small bowl combine remaining ingredients except blue cheese. Mix well and add to greens. Toss and sprinkle with blue cheese.

### Corn Dog Muffins

1 ( 8 ½ oz ) pkg cornbread mix  
½ c brown sugar  
½ c butter, melted & slightly cooled  
2 eggs, beaten  
1 c milk  
½ c shredded cheddar cheese  
4 hot dogs, cut into small pieces  
mustard & catsup for garnish

In a bowl combine dry corn bread mix, brown sugar, butter, eggs & milk; mix well. Fold in cheese & hot dogs. Fill greased muffin cups about ¾ full. Bake at 375 for 15 to 20 mins, until golden. Serve warm with mustard & catsup.

### Strawberry Rhubarb Pie

1 qt strawberries, washed, hulled & quartered  
1 c sugar  
1 ( 15 oz ) pkg refrigerated pie crusts, room temp  
1 c cubed fresh rhubarb  
1/3 c flour  
1 Tbl butter, melted

Preheat to 425. Combine berries & sugar, mix well until sugar dissolves. Unfold 1 crust and put in 9" deep dish pie plate. Add rhubarb, flour & butter to strawberries. Mix well and put into pie crust. Make cut outs into top crust for decorative crust and put on top. Pinch together and trim edges to seal. Bake 30 to 35 mins. Cool slightly before serving

Greetings from "The Little Corvair Shop in Memphis NY". Some months I have a hard time getting inspired to get this column together. Then I get rolling and run out of space! Sorry I am slow at it, but I am very busy here wondering when I can "retire"

I have been working out in the shop as much as I can stand. I rebuilt a starter and put it on the Rampy. I rebuilt both carbs and added a 3rd new fuel pump. I have a bunch of other stuff to do to make it look better this winter. I drove it to the Orphan car show in Minoa without any trouble. I do not understand why more Corvairs were not there. There were 300+ cars there. Anyhow I had a good time, but it is so different going places like Car shows and Ham radio shows alone.

One of my surprise adventures this month was a nice flight in a restored 1928 Ford Trimotor aircraft. It was a fun trip, and of course I took a few pictures. We took off from the Fulton EAA486 club hanger area and flew for @ 1/2 hour over the area. I will put a few pictures on another page and my website (<https://qsl.net/n2vzd/>) The 2 pictures below are of the corn silo on fire at the Ethanol plant just outside of Fulton. The brown one is still burning.

Last month I had a time getting all the crazy issues on Rampy fixed. It sounded like a head gasket, but ended up being a bad valve seat. And that same guide was loose causing the noise. When I went to adjust the valves, the starter made a grinding noise. Second starter made same noise. Ring gear was checked, and had no bad teeth. So I put a starter together with ALL new parts. It works. Then the fuel pump quit. I put a new Chinese lifetime warranty unit on. It lasted less than 5 minutes. A fuel pump on an FC is not fun to change. So I got a Carquest pump (made in USA sticker) and so far it works. This winter I hope to be able to clean up things in the motor area that got messed up doing all the repairs lately. I was trying to make sure the truck was running good for going to orphan show and the Jordan Fall Festival. I wonder if we are capable of getting to the Jordan show as a group. I do get there way early to capture our spot out back, but refuse to get in an argument over "saving spaces". Plus I never know who really is going to be there.

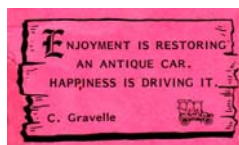
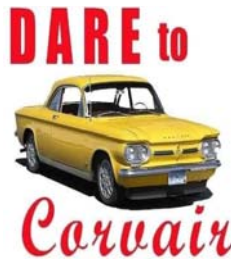
Also send pictures to the club website when you can. Let the rest of the Corvair world know what's going on here. You must be doing something to or with your vehicles? Let us know what you are doing.

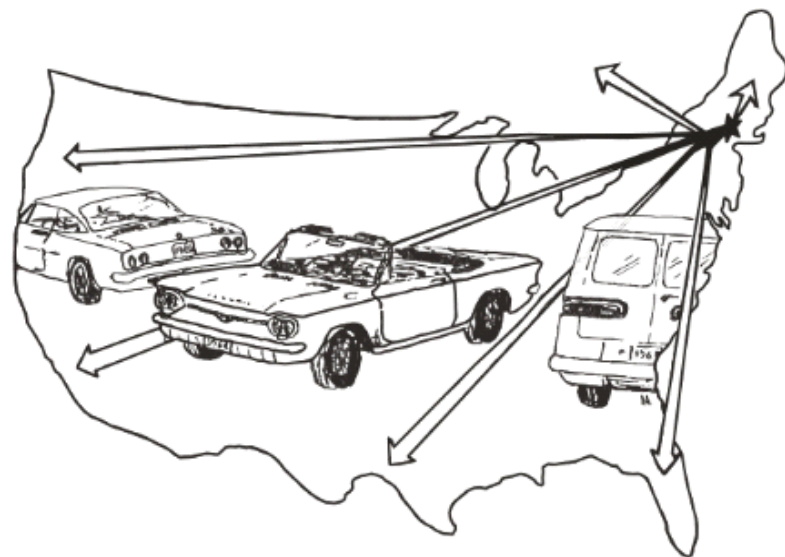
