Bacon and Egg Breakfast Tarts
Makes 4 small tarts

" Perfect selection for a brunch, but also convenient enough for serving on a weekday. Instead of Canadian ba-

try using 1/2 cup diced cooked ham or 1/2 cup crumbled cooked bacon. Place 2 tablespoons of meat into each pastry cup."

1 (11 ounce) package pie crust mix 1 (6 ounce) package Canadian-style bacon 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

4 eggs

1/4 cup milk

1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper Directions

1Preheat oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C).
2Prepare pastry for a one crust pie as directed on package. Divide pastry into 4 equal parts. Roll each part into a 6 inch circle on a well floured, cloth covered board with a floured, cloth covered rolling pin. Fit pastry over backs of large muffin cups (3 x 1 1/2 inch), or 6 ounce custard cups; make pleats so pastry will fit closely. If using individual pie pans or tart pans, cut circles 1 inch larger than inverted pans, and fit into pans. Prick surface. Place tarts on an ungreased cookie sheet.

3Bake until light brown, about 8 to 10 minutes. Cool 5 minutes, and carefully remove from cups. Reduce oven temperature to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

4Place 2 bacon slices in the bottom of each pastry cup. Sprinkle cheese over the meat, making slight well in centers. Break 1 egg into each. Add 1 tablespoon milk into each tart. Sprinkle with nutmeg and pepper. Place tarts on an ungreased cookie sheet
5Bake until eggs are soft cooked, about 15 to 20 min

This month I would like to tell you a story about my 64 A/C coupe. I bought it partly because it LOOKED exactly like the one I bought new in 1964. This one is originally from Texas. Body is very well preserved with about NO rust issues. The motor ran good for @2000 miles , then did loose a valve seat. I hade a very low miles 65 A/C powertrain here . I rebuilt the motor with .060 over full size cylinders and a upgraded Otto cam. Everything was gone thru , including the heeads, blower bearing. It has Clarks pans on it. It has Clark's dual STOCK muffler exhaust on 140hp manifolds. Rear bearings have been replaced. Front bearings and seals are new. I did this work a long time ago then set it aside for other projects. There is a trunk and car full of new Clark's parts, all cardboards , door panels , carpets etc. good Bumpers with guards.. The windshield has a wiper burn (not terrible) so I bought a used one and new gasket. It has Hands wheels with new tires (with a few miles) Now It needs paint etc to become a very nice car. I am no longer able to do this stuff , so it needs to be sold. If you are interested , let me know and set up a time to look it over. It runs strong , even on old gas. I need the space and the money.

I also found a brand new universal towbar in the shop I no longer need \$75.00 The headlights pictures are a set of 4 costly halogen that I want to sell. All sorts of things in the shop need to be sold.

I hope to get the truck cleaned up soon, I have been driving it a bit. It runs great. I have not been able to finish the Lakewood yet due to a lot of things going on. I also work on the long going project of the 8 door Van from Phil. Speaking of Phil, he plans on showing off his Loadside pickup. It came out of Dave's shop as a real gem. It has another of my motor creations in it. The side pipes sound great going thru the gears..

MY plans for car shows this year may not include as many as I would like but I will try for the Waterloo Wheels on Main ST. show, Fairhaven show, Port Byron, AACA at Clay town Park, The Jordan Fall festival, and the Orphan show in Minoa. I hope the rest of the club shows up also.

My 64 A/C coupe will be for sale soon. Long story.I bought this car in @2006. It is a formerTexas car, so no rust issues. I built the motor from a low mileage 65 A/C motor. It includes .060 full fin cylinders, Otto cam, the good electronic ignition I rebuilt the transmission and differential. I bought a lot of new parts, carpets, door panels, all cardboards. There are a LOT of new parts included. Most issues are paint and body. We drove the car for @ 2 years until I built the replacement motor when the one in the car dropped a valve seat because of incorrect work on shrouds. Windshield has a wiper burn, so a replacement glass and gasket are included. It has HANDS wheels with low mileage tires. It has a new padded dash.. You must look at it to understand the value of this package. \$8500 green cash
