Chicken-Cauliflower Casserole

1 (10 ounce) package frozen chopped cauliflower
1/2 Cup coarsely chopped onion
1/2 Cup water
1 Cup skim milk
1 Tablespoon cornstarch
1 Teaspoon low-sodium chicken-flavored bouillon granules
1/2 Teaspoon salt
1/4 Cup (1 ounce) shredded low-fat process American cheese
1 Cup chopped cooked chicken (skinned before cooking and cooked without salt)
1 (4ounce) jar diced pimiento, drained
Vegetable cooking spray.

Combine cauliflower, onion, and water in a medium saucepan; cover and bring to a boil. Reduce heat, and simmer 5 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Drain well, and set aside. Add milk, cornstarch, bouillon granules and salt to saucepan, stirring with a wire whisk. Bring to a boil; reduce heat, and simmer, stirring constantly, until thickened and bubbly. Add cheese: stir with wire whisk until cheese melts. Remove from heat. Add cauliflower mixture, chicken, and pimiento to cheese sauce. Spoon mixture into a 1-1/2-quart casserole coated with cooking spray. Bake at 325 degrees for 20 minutes or until thoroughly heated.

This is the wheel I need to replace on Rumpy. Any ideas where to look?

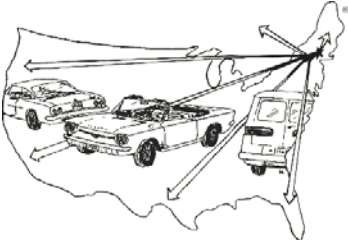

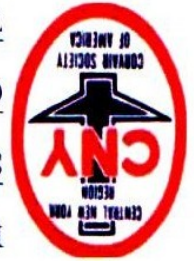
