November meeting will be Sunday 11/5 at 2pm, Come earlier to order lunch.

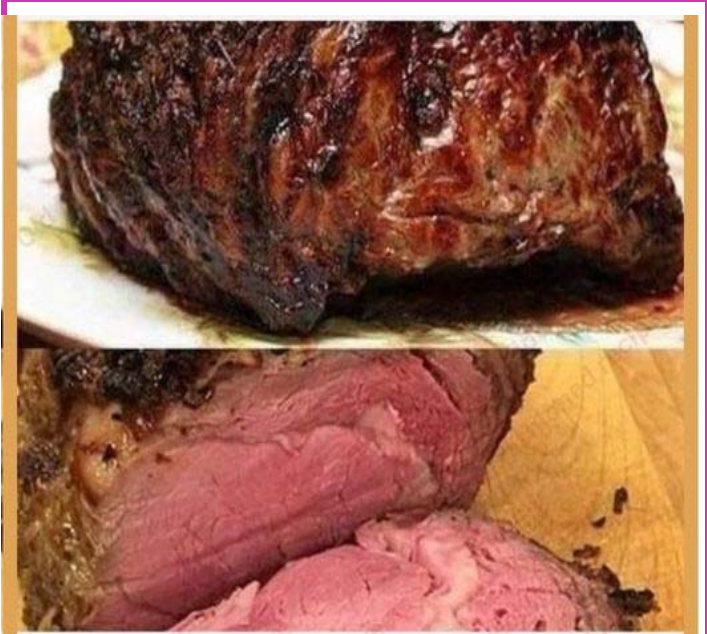
Our monthly meetings will be on Sunday's for the winter months at Jakes Grub and Grog in Brewerton where Castaways used to be.

PERFECT PRIME RIB EVERYTIME

INGREDIENTS

- 1 (4 pound) prime rib roast
- ¼ cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 tablespoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1 teaspoon herbes de Provence
- kosher salt to taste

PREPARATION

Place prime rib roast on a plate and bring to room temperature, 2 to 4 hours.

Preheat an oven to 500 degrees F (260 degrees C).

Combine butter, pepper, and herbes de Provence in a bowl; mix until well blended. Spread butter mixture evenly over entire roast. Season roast generously with kosher salt.

Roast the 4-pound roast in the preheated oven for 20 minutes. (If your roast is larger or smaller than 4 pounds, see footnote to calculate cooking time.)

Turn oven off and, leaving the roast in the oven with the door closed, let the roast sit in the oven for 2 hours.

Remove roast from the oven, slice, and serve.

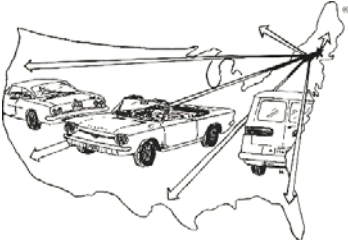

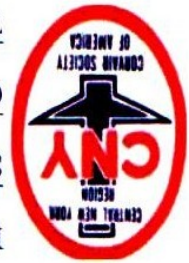
