### TIM'S TECH TIME AND RAMBLIN'S

This month has been another busy one. Right this moment I am working on newsletter watching snow again. It just switched from rain to big flakes. We have still been working hard at my house. Last week we went away for 43 days leaving my parts tumble on cleaning the hardware for Ramp's rear bumper and trailer hitch. I expected to find disaster when we got home, but all was good and parts super clean. I get some shop time, mostly working on Phil's 8 dr van. I am trying to get rid of a lot of things not needed. I have had many hobbies over the years accumulating lots of things. So did Rita. So cleanup has started. It is a huge undertaking.

A lot of my Corvair stuff must be sold, along with other radio things. I am making room in the shop to store another vehicle (not mine). I also will start selling off my book collection, Corvairs and Ham radio, soon.

I have a mystery project in the shop. I bought some motor cores from Ron before he died. I also ended up with 2 cars, which were rough and rusty, but had good motor, transmissions etc. I parted them out quickly. One was his pet project 63 4 door Monza. That motor is on the display trailer. The other was a 65 4 door with most of the A/C on it. The motor is a 95HP. I had those heads redone and put them on Rampy. The block is nice and was turning freely when I took it apart. Now after trying all my tricks, I can not get it to budge. It is as tight as I have ever encountered. I have heated the whole thing up with a 200,000 BTU heater, used a lot of P B Blaster and other chemicals on it. NOTHING moves at all. I was hoping to save the Torque converter, bellhousing, rods, and cylinders. Anybody up to a challenge, let me know. I am not ready to give up yet. How a nice smooth turning motor can end up that tight after @3 years is a mystery.

It has been nice seeing more people at the meetings. I hope it keeps up. Many years ago we had up to 240+ members doing all sorts of group things. I was #43 and Rita was #243 on membership list. Lots of memories. Some meetings were @ 40-50 people at the former "Ground Round" in Dewitt. We did rally's (sometimes with the SCCA group) and tours sometimes meeting up with other Corvair groups towards Rochester.

Recall 2024 planning is progressing nicely. I am glad to see it still going after all these years. It is not easy to do. Thanks to all involved.

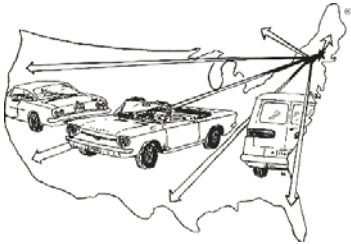

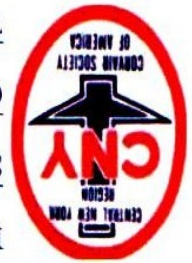
