Kitchen Corner

Farmhouse Pork & Cabbage Saute

4 bone in loin pork chops

34 tsp salt

1/4 tsp pepper

6 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled

1 onion, thinly sliced

1 (16oz) bag shredded coleslaw mix

2 golden delicious apples, cored and sliced

3/4 lb red skin potatoes, cubed

34 c apple cider

1/4 tsp thyme

1 Tbl vinegar

Season the chops and sauté in the bacon drippings; remove from pan. Sauté the onion, then add the coleslaw mix and cook 5 mins to wilt. Add apples, potatoes, cider, thyme. Bring to a boil then reduce heat, cover and simmer 15 – 20 mins. Stir in the vinegar. Return the chops to the pan, heat through and sprinkle with the bacon. Honey Kissed Acorn Squash 2 acorn squash, halved lengthwise and seeded

1 (8oz) can crushed pineapple, drained

1/4 c chopped pecans

1/4 c dried cranberries

1/4 c plus 2 Tbl honey

1/4 c butter, melted

optional; nutmeg

Micro the acorn on high 8 – 10 mins till tender. Mix the remaining ingredients except nutmeg and fill the squash. Micro 45 seconds on high. Sprinkle with nutmeg if desired.




