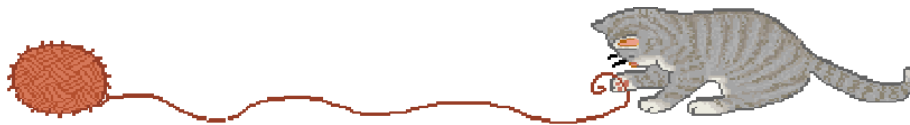
Meetings have returned to the first Thursday of the month. Located at the OTB Phoenix Sports Restaurant..

Chicken Spaghetti Casserole with Mushrooms Recipe

- 1 small box spaghetti
- 1-1/2 to 2 c. chopped, cooked chicken
- 1/4 c. pimento
- 1/4 c. chopped green pepper
- 1/2 c. chopped onion
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. pepper
- 1 (8 oz.) pkg. fresh mushrooms (sliced)
- 1 can chicken and mushroom soup
- 1/2 c. chicken broth
- 2 c. shredded American cheese

Cook spaghetti and drain. Saute green pepper, onion and mushrooms.
Add the rest of the ingredients and mix. Place in a greased casserole dish.
Cover and bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes. Mary J.

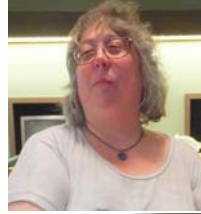
