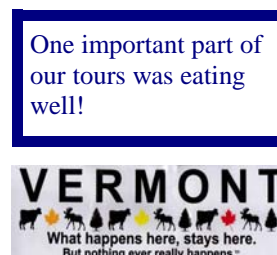

BOURBON BAKED HAM

Total Time

Prep: 15 min. Bake: 2-1/2 hours + standing

Makes

16 servings

Ingredients

1 fully cooked bone-in ham (8 to 10 pounds)
 3/4 cup bourbon, divided
 2 cups packed brown sugar
 1 tablespoon ground mustard
 1 tablespoon orange marmalade
 1/8 teaspoon ground coriander

Directions

Place ham on a rack in a shallow roasting pan. Score the surface of the ham, making diamond shapes 1/2 in. deep. Brush with 2 tablespoons bourbon. Bake, uncovered, at 325° for 2 hours.

In a small bowl, combine the brown sugar, mustard, marmalade, coriander and remaining bourbon; spoon over ham. Bake 30 minutes longer or until a thermometer reads 140°. Let stand for 15 minutes before slicing.

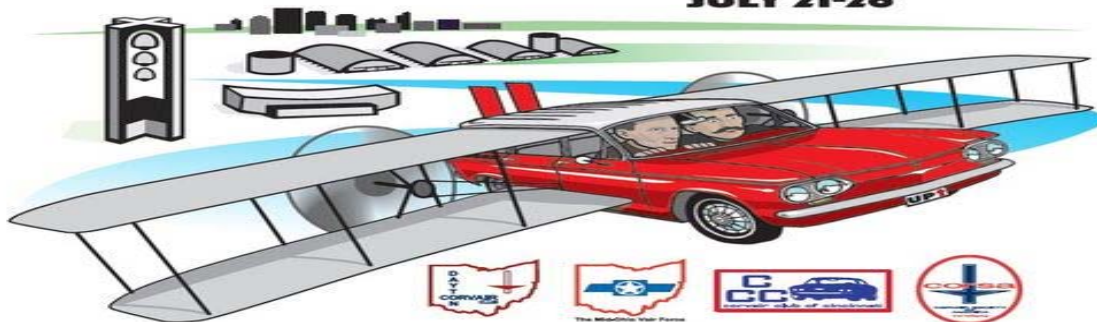
1964 Monza coupe with factory A/C, modified 110hp powerglide 3:27 differential. This car is originally from Texas, so no real rust, and the paint was destroyed by heat. I bought this car in 2006 to drive and enjoy. We drove it @2 years before the "rebuilt" motor tossed #1 exhaust seat. I had a 65 A/C motor with very low miles as a core (been setting a long time). So I rebuilt it my way with Clark's full fin .060 stuff, rebuilt heads from a shop near Boston, everything new. Cam is Otto OT20. It has high output alternator conversion, redone starter, transmission, differential, and brakes etc. I think ALL parts needed are in it new or rebuilt. Carpets, interior kit, padded dash, bumpers with guards, weatherstrips, and more. Brakes and all wheel bearings etc all done before I drove it the first time. Imagine how much I put into it. There is a sunguard silver cover included. The car is apart needing paint prep and paint. It has a Spyder Dash in black wrinkle paint. It has a spare windshield with new gasket to replace the one which came with some wiper burn. It has HANDS wheels with tires. It has Clark's dual exhaust. It has the Clark's C2851 ignition system on it. I last registered and inspected it in 2015 with my wifes Ham Call (now passed). Miles showing are 82,528. 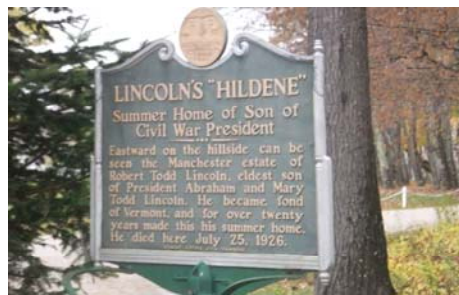

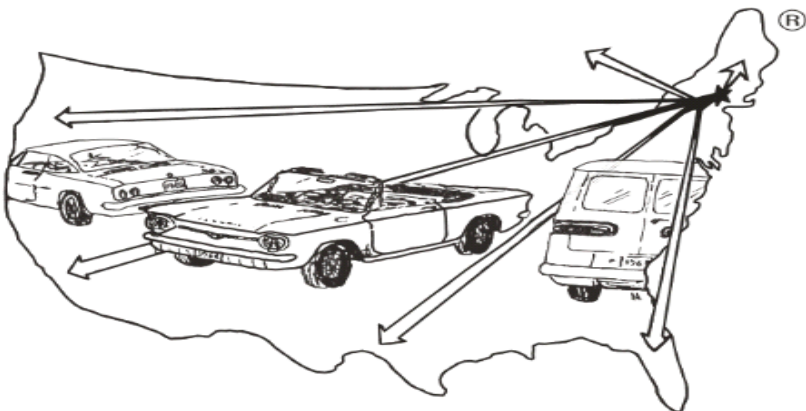

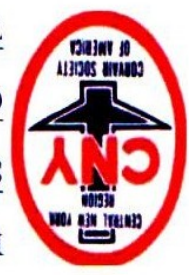
