CALIFORNIA CASSEROLE

1 (18 oz.) pkg. mixed vegetables (any combination)
2 or 3 tomatoes, cut in wedges salt and pepper to taste 1 stick melted butter 1/3 c. bread crumbs 1/4 c. grated Parmesan cheese 2 Tsp. grated Swiss cheese 2 Tbsp. grated Cheddar cheese

Butter a 10-inch casserole dish and arrange from vegetables inside. Place tomatoes around edges. Sprinkle we salt and pepper and 1/2 of the melted butter. Combine brown crumbs and cheese. Sprinkle over vegetables, Drizzle remain butter. Bake at 375° for 30 minutes or until cheese is brown and bubbly.




