Kitchen Corner By Rita

Seafood Bake

½ lb grated sharp cheddar
1 can asparagus spears, drained
5 oz lobster meat, chopped
6 oz crabmeat, chopped
5 oz shrimp
2 cans cream of mushroom soup
2 cans sliced mushrooms
½ c bread crumbs
½ c slivered almonds

Put asparagus spears in buttered casserole dish. Sprinkle with half of the cheese. Top with all the seafood. Combine the soup and mushrooms; spread over top. Then top with bread crumbs, the rest of the cheese and the almonds. Bake at 350° till bubbly.

Pink Grapefruit Punch

4 c water, divided
2 Tbl confectioners sugar
2 c pink grapefruit juice
1 (12oz) frozen lemonade
thawed
3 Tbl maraschino cherry juice

Combine ¼ c water with sugar and micro on high for 30 seconds; cool. Combine with remaining ingredients, including the remaining water. Chill before serving.

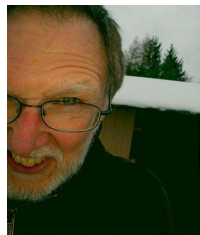

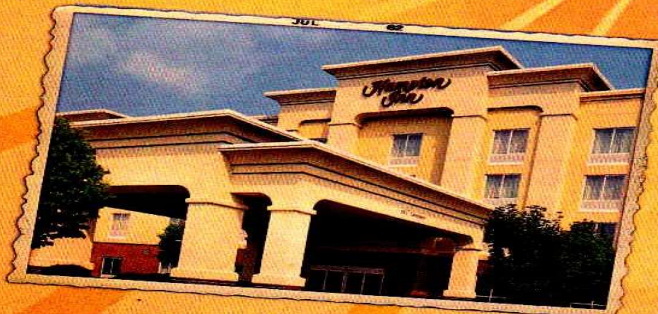

From central New Hampshire came Paul and Evelyn Ardito with their striking black-on-red four-speed 1963 Spyder. It features a 150-horsepower engine.

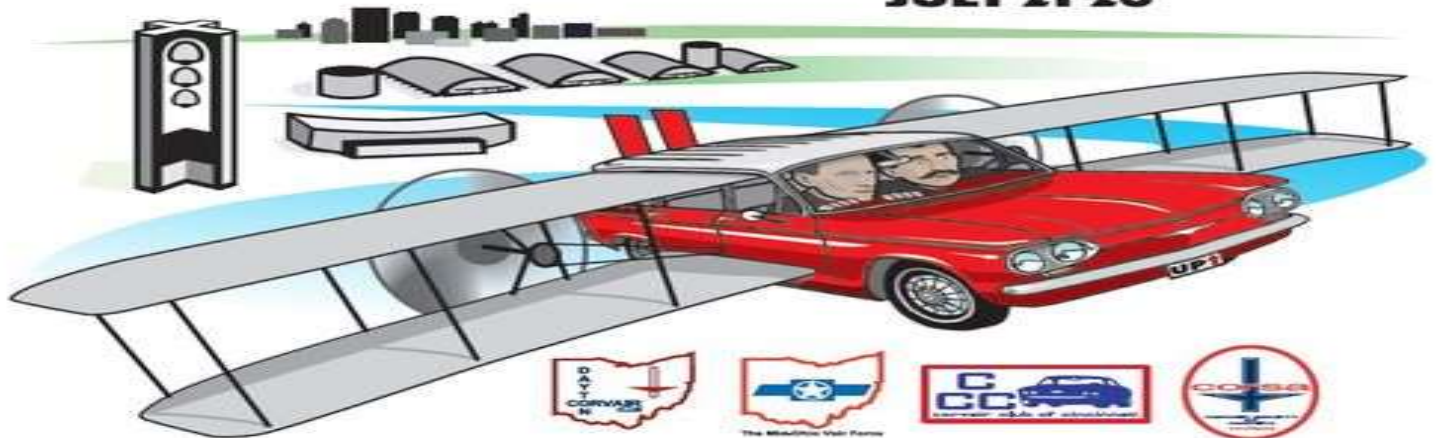

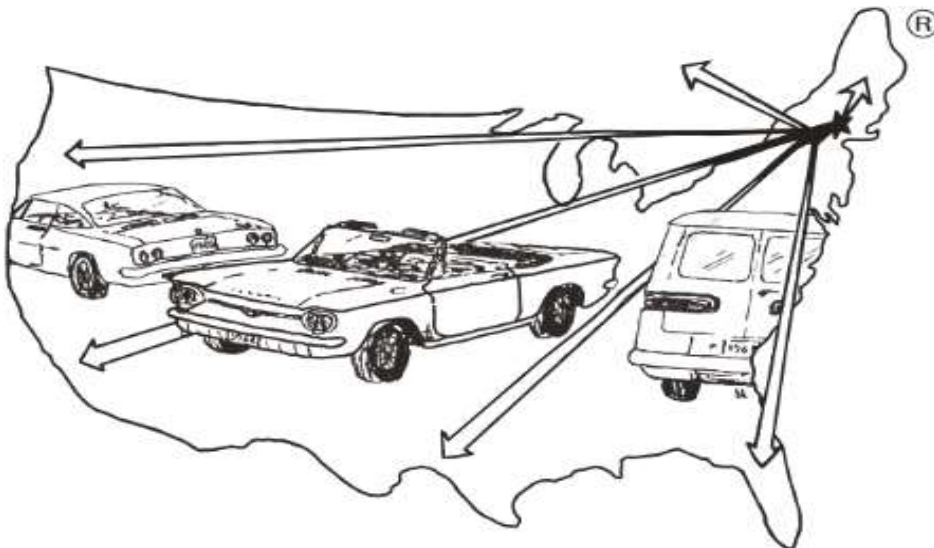
