


## Kitchen Corner By Rita

#### Bacon Pie

Makes 1 -10-inch pie

12 slices bacon
1 cup shredded Swiss cheese
1/3 cup chopped onion
2 cups milk
4 eggs
1 cup baking mix
1/8 teaspoon ground black pepper
Directions



- 2 Sprinkle bacon, cheese, and onion in pie plate.
- 3 In a medium bowl, stir milk, eggs, baking mix, and pepper with fork until blended. Pour into pie plate.
- 4 Bake 35 to 40 minutes or until knife inserted in center comes out clean.
