





Kitchen Corner **By Rita, KC2GFT Beef Stromboli** ¹/₂ lb sweet Italian Sausage ¹/₄ lb ground beef 1 (7oz) can mushrooms, drained 1 lb frozen bread dough, thawed ¹/₂ c shredded mozzerella 1 tsp parmesan ¹/₂ tsp garlic powder 1/8 tsp each salt & pepper Brown and drain the sausage and beef. Add mushrooms and remove from heat. Roll dough out to 6 x 12 rectangle and Spread meat mixture. Mix remaining ingredients and sprinkle over meat. Fold dough over and pinch to seal. Put on greased baking sheet and bake at 425° For 15 – 18 mins.

Maple Apple Crunch 8 baking apples, peeled, cored & sliced 2 Tbl flour ³/₄ c sugar 1 c maple syrup, divided 1 tsp cinnamon 1¹/₂ c oatmeal $1\frac{1}{2}$ c flour ³/₄ c brown sugar ³/₄ c melted butter 1 tsp baking soda 1 tsp baking powder ¹/₂ c chopped nuts Combine 1^{st} 5 ingredients with $\frac{1}{2}$ c of the syrup. Put in ungreased 8 x 12 pan or 9" pie tin. Combine remaining ingredients with 1/2 c syrup and top the apples. Bake 350° 40 mins.

NOTE: Rita was also a licensed amateur radio operator and was very proud of her achievement getting the General Class ticket (next to top level!).
